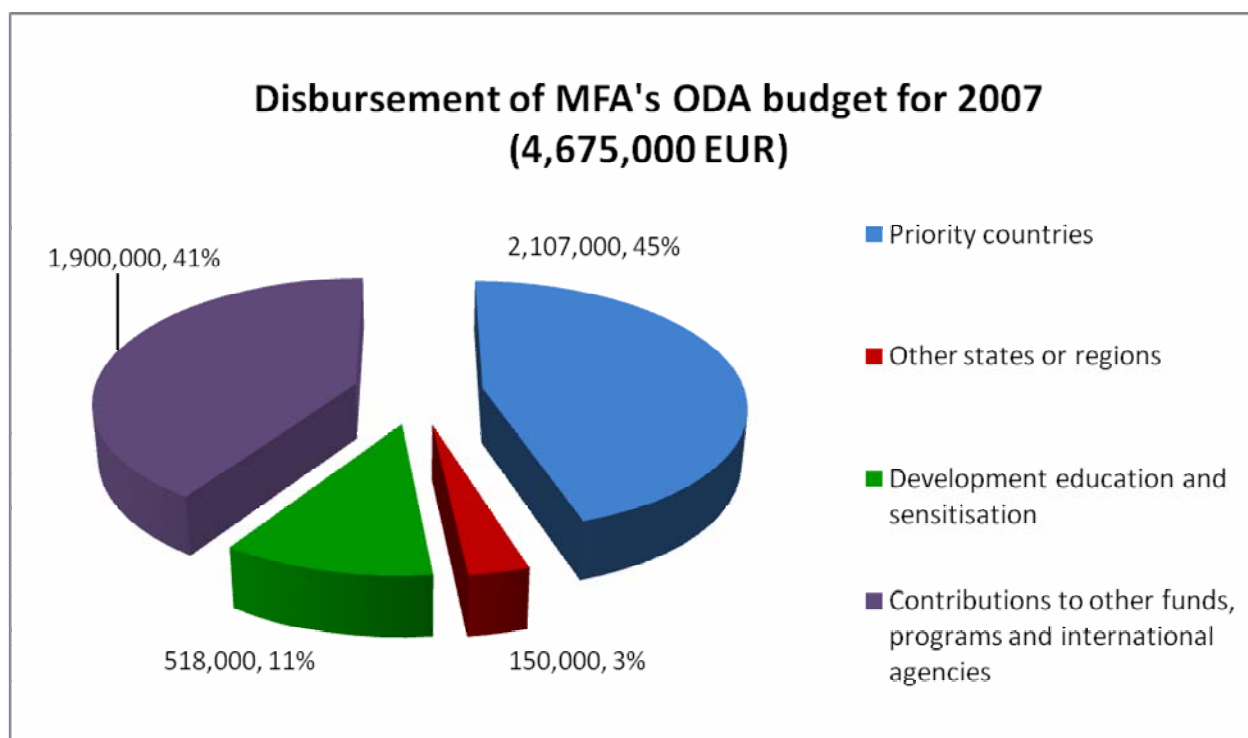


Disbursement of MFA's ODA Budget for 2007 (4,675,000 EUR)

In 2007 the MFA's ODA budget amounted to 4,675,000 EUR, the whole ODA budget being allocated through multilateral channels.

The geographical breakdown of the ODA budget for 2007 was done according to the figure below:



In detail, the MFA's ODA budget was used for:

I. Contributions to the benefit of priority countries

The Republic of Moldova: 996,864 EUR

- Social development: "Better Opportunities for Youth and Women", project which supported the establishment of the Social Reintegration Center in Telenesti – 400,000 EUR;
- Public Local Governance: "Integrated Local Development Strategies" – 160,000 EUR;
- Civil Society: "Civil Society Development Organization" – 140,000 EUR;
- Water supply systems in rural areas: "Drinking water supply systems in rural areas" – 100,000 EUR;

- Following the implementation of the SNIECODA project in 2009, the sum of 150,000 USD (about 115,000 EUR) was reassigned from the project's budget and transferred to UNDP Moldova in order to implement a cooperation program between the two countries' civil society representatives in the field of human rights;
- United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA) for activities in the Republic of Moldova (the development of an informational system for domestic violence) – 81,864 EUR;

Georgia: 692,000 EUR

- “Regional Development in the Kakheti region” – 150,000 EUR;
- “Economic Development in the Autonomous Republic of Adjara” – 150,000 EUR;
- Following the implementation of the SNIECODA project in 2009, the sum of 250,000 USD (about 192,000 EUR) was reassigned from this project's budget and transferred to UNDP Georgia, in order to implement a cooperation program between the two countries' civil society representatives in the field of human rights;
- Contribution to the UN Refugee Agency (UNHCR) – Program for refugees and displaced persons in Georgia – 100,000 EUR;
- Contribution to the UN World Food Programme (WFP) – Operation for Georgia – 100,000 EUR;

Republic of Serbia: 418,136 EUR

- Strengthening the rule of law – “Transitional Justice, War Crimes Trials and Notions of Justice” – 200,000 EUR;
- Strengthening rural financial networks – “Strengthening of Rural Capital and Networks” – 200,000 EUR;
- Contribution to the integration of the Roma minority in Serbian society - Romanian model implementation in three cities (implemented by UNFPA) – 25,000 USD (about 18,136 EUR);

II. Contributions to the benefit of other states or regions

Middle East

- UN Agency for Palestine Refugees in the Near East (UNRWA) – 150,000 EUR.

III. Development education and awareness raising

- Education and information programs in the field of development and institutional capacity building in Romania's development assistance – the SNIECODA project - the initial and the final values were 825,000 EUR (following the 2009 decision to reallocate some funds remaining unused) and 518.000 EUR, respectively. The program was implemented in cooperation with UNDP Romania.

IV. Contributions to other funds, programs and international agencies, with thematic destination

- United Nations Democracy Fund (UNDEF) – 200,000 EUR;

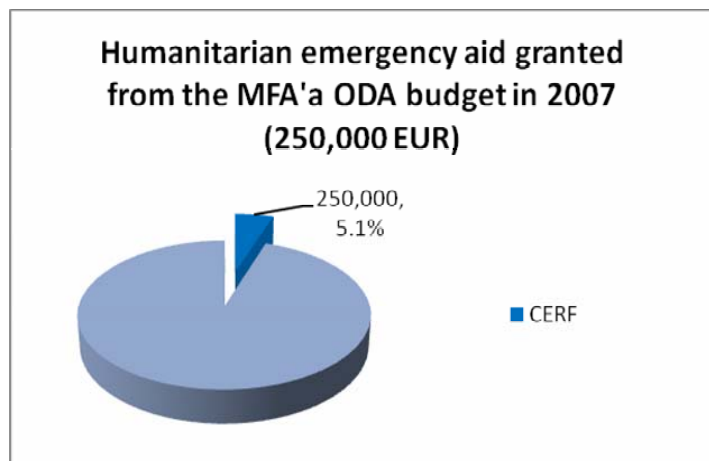

- “Education for All” Fund (managed by IBRD) – 300,000 EUR;

World Trade Organization (WTO): 100,000 EUR

- Global Investment Fund for the DOHA Agenda – 100,000 EUR.

Based on the above information, the humanitarian emergency aid granted from the MFA's ODA budget for 2007 amounted to 250,000 EUR, representing a contribution to the **United Nations Central Emergency Response Fund (CERF)**.

It represents about 5.34% of the ODA's total budget for the mentioned year.
